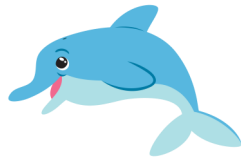
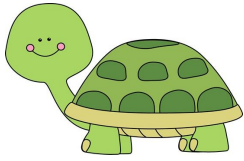

## **Theme: Water Wonderland**

### **Week 1: *Water In Our World***

- Brainstorm different ways we use water.
- “Paint” with water outside.
- Develop fine motor skills while drawing wiggly wave patterns.

### **Week 2: *Sailing Away***

- Use the water table to predict if an object will sink or float, then chart their observations.
- Retell our unit book All Aboard by acting it out.
- Use blocks to create a boat and tell where they would go on that boat.

### **Week 3: *Animals That Live In or Near The Water***

- Use cognitive skills to sort which animals live in the water and which live around or near water.
- Use containers holding similar items to identify which has more and which has fewer items.
- Develop fine motor skills while working with collage materials to make colorful fish.

### **Week 4: *Rain and Rainbows***

- Use spray bottles outside to make a rainbow.
- Use the rhyme “Pitter Patter” to learn how flowers need rain.
- Use colored seashells to practice patterning.
